Plant your Future is a grassroots international environmental charity with a bold vision: to restore the Amazon rainforest.

We work hand-in-hand with smallholder Amazonian farming families, helping them adopt regenerative agroforestry practices that restore degraded land, protect biodiversity and create sustainable, resilient livelihoods.

Through our model, farmers grow native trees alongside crops, producing sustainably harvested fruit, timber and carbon credits. This approach not only combats climate change and biodiversity loss—it empowers farmers with long-term income and ownership over their land's restoration.

Since our founding, we've partnered with 62 rural communities in the Peruvian Amazon and planted over 900,000 trees across 248 farms.
